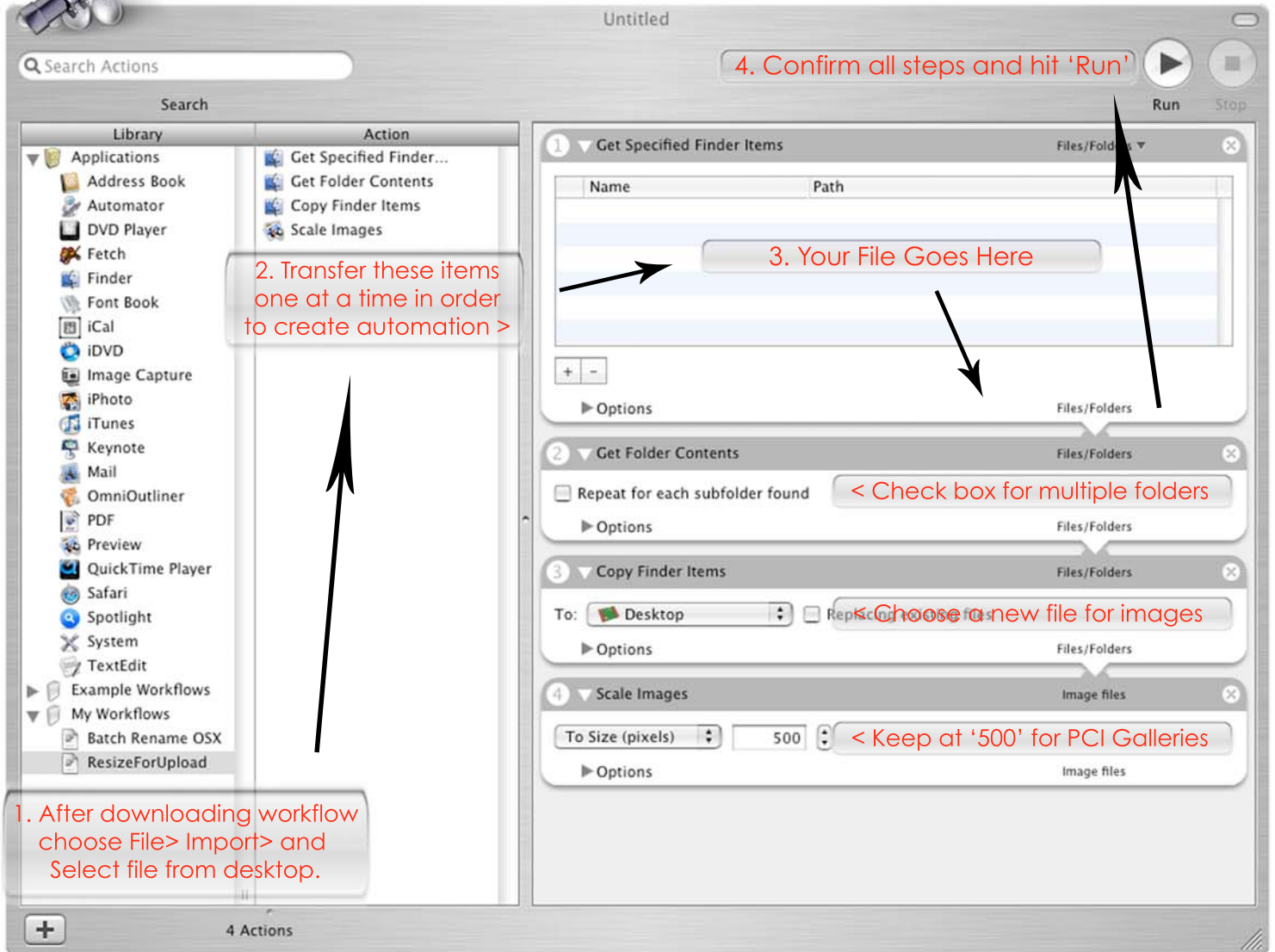


Mac OSX Automator Action for Batch Resizing (500px)



This is a quick tutorial on resizing entire folders with the Automator in Mac OSX

1. Download Workflow file from blog post.
2. Import the Workflow into Automator. File> Import.
3. Transfer 'Actions' one at a time in order listed to create 4 steps.
 - Step one - Choose your file with images to be renamed.
 - Step two - Leave this as is unless you have any sub-folders to also be resized.
 - Step three - Select drop menu and choose 'other', this will allow you to create a new folder on your desktop to place the new images into.
 - Step four - Choose size. Pacific Color Galleries requires images no bigger than 500px at their longest edge. Leave this action at it's default '500' for this.
4. Hit 'Run' and wait for the magic to happen.

Bonus! - If you want to resize and rename at the same time, take the 'Rename Finder Item' step from our 'Batch Rename OSX' workflow and drag it inbetween step 3 and 4. (Amazing!)
