

Irfanview Tutorial for Windows Users 'Batch Resize'



4. START >

< BEGIN HERE >
1. Add Images to be resized here

2. Select new folder for output here

< Select 'Batch Conversion'

Select 'Advance Options'

This will open a new window >

***To get to this window:
Open File Menu >
Batch Conversion/Rename
or hit 'B' on keyboard**

**DO NOT press this button unless
you want to overwrite your files!**

3. Set size. 500px at long side for PCI Galleries

USE THESE

Hit OK! Window will close >

This tutorial covers how to resize images with 'Irfanview' a free program for Windows users.

Download and install 'Irfanview'. Link is on Blog post.

Open Irfanview, press 'B' on keyboard.

1. Choose files to resize within search dialog box. Press 'Add' or 'Add all'.
2. Select a new file to copy and resize images to. DO NOT overwrite original files!
3. Press 'Set Advance Options' and type a new size. Pacific Color Galleries requires images no larger than 500px at their longest side.
4. Hit 'OK!'. This will close options window. Press 'Start' at top of original window.

Your Done! Navigate to new folder and confirm images were resized properly.

***Bonus!** Combine both resize and rename by selecting
'Batch Conversion - Rename Result Files' after step 2.
